


# MANITOU FORK FITMENT GUIDE



## 1 DETERMINE WHEEL SIZE



### 1a CONSULT BICYCLE MANUFACTURER

Information should be in the bicycle models spec sheet or geometry chart


### 1b CHECK SIDEWALL OF THE FRONT TIRE

### 1c CONFIRM THE WHEEL SIZE

Have a qualified bicycle technician confirm the wheel size

*Common wheel sizes include: 20", 24", 26", 27.5", & 29".  
For plus and fat tires (2.8" and larger), please consult the fork owners manual for tire fitment guidelines.*

## 2 FORK TRAVEL



### 2a CONSULT BICYCLE MANUFACTURER

Information should be in the bicycle models spec sheet or geometry chart

### 2b FIND TRAVEL INFORMATION

Try to locate a sticker or marking on the current fork with the travel information

*Common fork travels include: 80mm, 100mm, 120mm, 140mm, 160mm, 180mm, & 203mm.*

## 3 AXLE SIZE AND TYPE



### 3a CONSULT THE CURRENT FORK MANUFACTURER

### 3b IDENTIFY AXLE TYPE

Have a qualified bicycle technician measure the diameter and identify the axle type

*Common axle size and type include: 9mm Quick Release, 15mm Thru Axle, & 20mm Thru Axle.*

## 4 DROPOUT SPACING




### 4a CONSULT THE CURRENT FORK MANUFACTURER

### 4b IDENTIFY AXLE SPACING

Have a qualified bicycle technician measure the diameter and identify the axle type

*Common drop out spacing and type include: 100mm Quick Release, 100mm Thru Axle, & 110mm Thru Axle.*

## 5 STEERER TUBE



### 5a CONSULT BICYCLE MANUFACTURER

Information should be in the bicycle models spec sheet or geometry chart

### 5b CONSULT THE CURRENT FORK MANUFACTURER

### 5c IDENTIFY STEERER TYPE

Have a qualified bicycle technician measure the upper and lower diameter and identify the steerer type

*1 1/8" straight steerer tubes will measure 28.55mm at the top and 30mm at the crown race seat. 1.5" Tapered steerer tubes will measure 28.55mm at the top and 39.8mm at the crown race seat.*

## 6 OFFSET



### 6a CONSULT BICYCLE MANUFACTURER

Consult bicycle Manufacturer, Information should be in bicycle models spec sheet or geometry chart

### 6b CONSULT THE CURRENT FORK MANUFACTURER

*Offsets vary widely depending on the wheel size and geometry of the bike, most fall in between 37mm and 57mm.*
